Based on data from 87 countries, 1 in 5 women and girls under the age of 50 will have experienced physical and/or sexual violence by an intimate partner within the last 12 months. Progress on Achieving SDG 5 - Gender Equality

Norway is the only country that has achieved Gender Equality. USA, Turkey, Japan, Korea, and Latvia are the countries most challenged with gender inequality. Globally, gender inequality runs through all the SDGs. 330M women (41 M more than men) globally live in extreme poverty (under \$1/day). In nearly 2/3 countries, women are more likely than men to report for food insecurity. Globally 15M girls compared to 10M boys will never get to read or write. Strategic policies to improve gender equality are imperative because, women are underrepresented in policy making. Globally, 24.9% of parliamentarians are women and 6.6% of CEOs of Fortune 500 companies are women.
